1st grade tours focus on concepts aligned to Next Generation Sunshine State Standards. Students will explore each topic through guided activities in the new Mosaic Backyard Universe, classrooms, and related exhibits, including The Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat and/or The Planetarium. Teachers may choose from 4 available options:

Connections: Where in the World?

Key Concepts: What are the key parts of maps/globes? How do we use maps/ alobes?

Includes: Visits to the Manatee Habitat and The Planetarium.

Life Science: **Putting Down Roots**

Key Concepts: What parts do plants have, and what do they do? How do plants grow?

Includes: Visit to the Manatee Habitat.

Earth & Space Science: Sun and Stars

Key Concepts: What is a star/the Sun? What is the impact of the Sun on life on Farth?

Includes: Visit to The Planetarium.

Physical Science: Forces in Motion

Key Concepts: What makes something move? What are the different ways things move?

Includes: Visit to The Planetarium.
