

Early Learning Guided Tours Pre-kindergarten

Connect with science and nature at The Bishop!

Pre-K tours focus on concepts aligned to Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards. Students will explore each topic through guided activities in the new *Mosaic Backyard Universe*, classrooms, and related exhibits, including The Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat and/or The Planetarium. Teachers may choose from 4 available options:

Connections: Step Into Light (and Shadows)

Standards: VI.C.1.e, VI.D.1.c, VII.D.4, VI.A.1.b

Key Concepts: What is a shadow? Where does light come from? Why is light important?

Includes: Visits to the Manatee Habitat and The Planetarium.

Earth & Space Science: Water, Water Everywhere!

Standards: VI.D.1.a, VI.E.1.a, VI.C.1.d, VI.B.1.e

Key Concepts: Where do we find water? Who uses water? How does water move?

Includes: Visit to the Manatee Habitat.

Life Science: Plant or Animal?

Standards: VI.B.1.a, VI.B.1.b, VI.B.1.e

Key Concepts: What is an animal? What is a plant?

Includes: Visit to the Manatee Habitat.

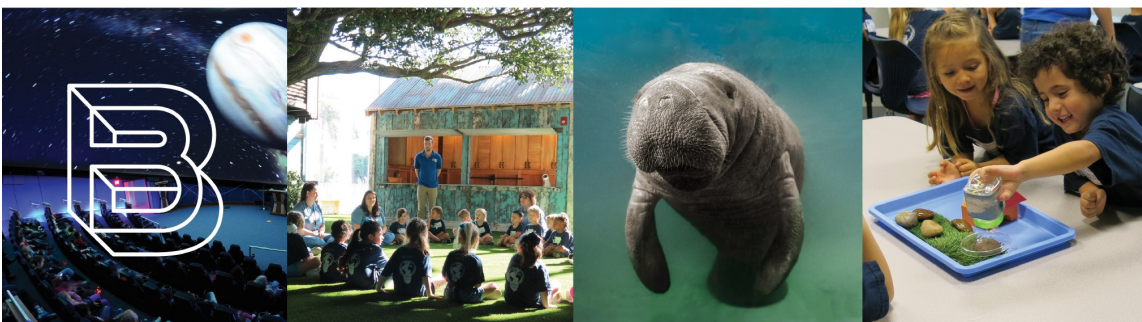
Physical Science: Move It!

Standards: VI.C.1.b, VI.F.1.a, VI.F.1.b, VI.F.1.d

Key Concepts: What makes something move? How can we control or change the movement?

Includes: Visit to The Planetarium.
