Connect with science and nature at The Bishop!

2nd grade tours focus on concepts aligned to Next Generation Sunshine State Standards. Students will explore each topic through guided activities in the new *Mosaic Backyard Universe*, classrooms, and related exhibits, including The Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat and/or The Planetarium. Teachers may choose from 4 available options:

Connections: Habitat, Sweet Habitat

Key Concepts: What are basic needs? What is a habitat and how do they vary?

Includes: Visits to the Manatee Habitat

and The Planetarium.

Earth & Space Science: Florida Rocks!

Standards: SC.2.E.6.1, SC.2.E.6.2, SC.2.E.6.3

Key Concepts: Earth is made up of rocks. What is a rock? What is soil?

Includes: Visit to The Planetarium.

Life Science: Cycles of Life

Standards: SC.2.L.16.1

Key Concepts: How do you know if something is living? What is a life cycle?

Includes: Visit to the Manatee Habitat.

Physical Science: What's the Matter?

Standards: SC.2.P.8.2, SC.2.P.8.3,

SC.2.P.8.4

Key Concepts: What is matter? What are the different types of matter?

Includes: Visit to The Planetarium.
