Includes: Visits to the Mosaic Backyard Universe, the Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat, The Planetarium, and the classroom

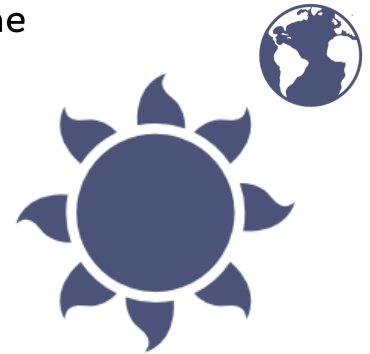


Earth & Space Science: Sun and Stars
