Administrative Support	Flexible shifts available Monday thru Friday, 9am-4pm. If you are detail-oriented and enjoy working in a friendly office environment, then volunteering with the Marketing, Community Engagement and Finance teams may be a good fit for you. As Administrative Support, you will assist in a variety of ways, including assembling paper mailings for the Discovery Society, helping with basic data entry, and answering phones, in addition to filing, archiving and performing other office tasks as needed.
Education Collections	Flexible shifts available Wednesday thru Friday, 9am-4pm. If you are detail-oriented and have a passion for fossils, shells, or cultural history, then volunteering to help care for our Education Collections may be a good fit for you. Our Education Collections feature fossil evidence of Florida's earliest animal inhabitants, specimens (shells, dried specimens) of modern animal inhabitants, and geologic specimens (rocks and minerals). As Education Collections Support, you will assist Education staff with data entry, photography, labeling, and rehousing artifacts and specimens. Some volunteer opportunities may be customized based on volunteer interests, knowledge, and skills.
Education Support IQuest	IQuest is held on the second Saturday of each month from 4-8pm. IQuest is a monthly STEAM-enrichment program at The Bishop for students in grades 6-8. The event includes a pizza dinner, and students participate in various art and STEM activities based on a different theme for each program. IQuest Support includes assisting with set up and breakdown, greeting attendees and confirming their registration, and supervising activities and challenges. This program is entirely activity based, so volunteers provide direct supervision and guidance for students going through the theme's "challenges". Requires ability to climb stairs, stoop and stand for extended periods of time.
Education Support MBU Expedition Guide	Shifts are available Wed-Sat 10:30am-2pm and Sun 12:30-4:00pm. The Mosaic Backyard Universe (MBU) at The Bishop is a permanent facilitated exhibition designed to support inquiry and play-based learning for young guests and their families. While created with early learners in mind, guests of all ages are welcome to enjoy the exhibition. When visiting the MBU, families are encouraged to explore and discover the various areas. As a MBU Expedition Guide, you will guide and interact with guests, provide information, ask questions to promote inquiry and discovery, and monitor and maintain safety of all guests, animals, and collection items. Requires ability to climb stairs, stoop and stand for extended periods of time.

	questions to promote inquiry and discovery, and monitor and maintain safety of all
	guests, animals, and collection items. Requires ability to climb stairs, stoop and stand for
	extended periods of time.
	Shifts are available Wed-Sat 10am-12:30pm and 12:30-3pm, and Sun 12-4pm.
	If you have a passion for meeting new people and providing stellar customer service, then
	volunteering in visitor services may be a good fit for you. As a Museum Greeter, you will
Museum	be stationed at the information desk near the main entrance to welcome visitors to the
Greeter	Museum, sign-up guests for their seating assignment in the Planetarium, assist with
	directional and general information, and answer questions related to programs,
	exhibitions and Museum features to help ensure positive, enjoyable and memorable
	experiences for our guests. This is a seated position with some standing.

Planetarium	As Planetarium Support, you will warmly greet guests, answer questions related to the
Support	shows, share general expectations and rules, aid with seating, and monitor the doors
	while shows are in progress. Requires ability to stand and walk for extended periods of time.
	Hours vary based on event; possible evening hours.
	As Special Events Support, you will assist where needed on special event days, including
Special Events Support	but not limited to Smithsonian Museum Day and Summer Learning Day. Volunteers will
	monitor activities and exhibitions, manage questions about event details, wayfinding, and
	general inquiries about The Bishop, assist with crowd management and help to ensure
	visitors' safety and enjoyment. You will be shown your assignment when you arrive and
	instructed on the activities and tasks for your area.
