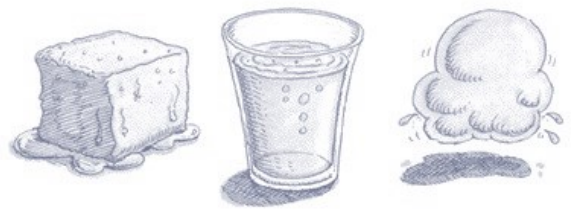


Physical Science: What's the Matter?
