Students will explore a chosen topic through guided activities in the Mosaic Backyard Universe, classrooms, and related exhibits, including the Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat and/or The Planetarium.

Teachers may choose from these options:

Connections: Step Into Light (and Shadows)

Standards: VI.C.1.e, VI.D.1.c, VII.D.4, VI.A.1.b

Key Concepts: What is a shadow? Where does light come from? Why is light important?

Includes: Visits to the Mosaic Backyard Universe, the Visible Storage Gallery, the Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat, and The Planetarium



Life Science: Plant or Animal?

Standards: VI.B.1.a, VI.B.1.b, VI.B.1.e

Key Concepts: What is an animal? What is a plant? How are they similar and different?

Includes: Visits to the Mosaic Backyard Universe, Pine Uplands, Riverine, the Parker Manatee Rehabilitation Habitat, and the classroom
